Abundant solar energy is available in the Sydney metropolitan area. If 25% of the houses each installed 35 square metres of solar panels, this could deliver all the energy for the city's households. We conservatively estimate a total yield of 195kWh/m² of PV panel placed on roofs or other horizontal surfaces.
